What is it:

The goals of Wraparound are to attain positive outcomes by providing a structured and creative team planning process that allows the family to learn problem solving skills, coping skills and self-efficiency.

■ Who is it for:

- Wraparound is for those 0-18 of age, who qualify under Community Mental Health Services. The Wraparound process involved four phases of effort:
 - Engagement and team preparation
 - Initial plan development
 - Implementation
 - Transition

Services Provided:

- Care Coordination
- Building family support systems
- Crisis intervention and prevention
- Safety planning
- Life skills education
- Individualized support
- Referral assistance for family needs
- Access to community resources

Program Objectives:

- Empower youth families
- Provide for a stable family unit
- Decrease out-of-home placement
- Improve school performance
- Promote positive emotional and behavioral functioning
- Decrease interactions with the legal system

- Must be authorized by CMH for services
